E. Required Nomination Documents - Checklist

Formatting for Attachments:

- Pages must be 8 ½" x 11" (216 mm x 279 mm)
- Insert a minimum margin of 2 cm (3/4") around the page (top, bottom and sides)
- Text can be either single- or double-spaced
- Use a minimum font size of 11 (Arial or Times New Roman) with no condensed type
- In the header of each page, indicate the title of the document (e.g. Cover Letter) in the top left and the name of the nominee in the top right

Required Attachments

1. Cover Letter (Maximum 2 pages)

- Signed by both the Dean and the Nominee
- The letter should address:
 - o The significance of the Nominee's research
 - A narrative of the nominee's career to date and how they exhibit leadership in their area of research
 - The potential impact of the research
 - Any cross-faculty or interdisciplinary aspects of the research
 - o How the research aligns with the University's areas of research strength
- The letter must confirm at least 75% protected research or research-related activity time for the nominee over the term of the Fellowship

2. Nominee's Current CV (No page limit)

• Any standard CV format will be acceptable and can be structured based on the nominee's discipline, but must include a **publication list**.

3. Most Significant Contributions (Up to 2 pages)

• The Nominee should identify and briefly describe up to five significant contributions related to research or leadership/service over the Nominee's entire career. Emphasis should be on the nominee's contributions as an independent scholar and the extent to which the nominee has contributed to research excellence and innovation in their chosen field in Canada and internationally relative to their career stage

4. Two (2) External Letters of Support (Up to 2 pages per letter):

- Letters must include referee's full name, mailing address and signature.
- At least one (1) referee must be arm's length
- Letters must be sent directly from the Referees to the respective Dean for inclusion in the Nomination Package.
