



For SAR recording purposes, what is considered a Morbidity?

- (i) **Morbidity** is any sick animal who responds to humane interventions or remains stable in their condition and meets expected or SAR directed expedited experimental endpoint.

For SAR recording purposes, what is considered a Mortality?

- (ii) **Continued Morbidity** is any sick animal who does not respond to Veterinary-directed humane interventions and whose declining health requires early euthanasia and does not meet experimental.
- (iii) **Mortality (no SAR)** is any animal found dead without an active SAR case.
- (iv) **Mortality (SAR)** is any animal found dead with an active SAR case open.
- (v) **Mortality (SAR Directed)** is any animal for which euthanasia was performed as directed by SAR Designates and/or veterinarians.
- (vi) **Mortality (PI Directed)** is any animal for which euthanasia was performed as directed by the PI or their designate.
- (vii) **PI Mortality** is any sick animal who the PI staff found dead or was euthanized before experimental endpoint. This information is to be recorded by the PI as part of their AUP renewal.
