Currently accepting nominations for: Two (2) members of faculty for terms from July 1, 2025 to June 20, 2028. No more than two faculty members shall be from the same Faculty.

Five (5) undergraduate students for terms from July 1, 2025 to June 30, 2026. Undergraduate students shall be appointed from a broad range of Faculties.

Three (3) graduate students for terms from July 1, 2025 to June 30, 2026. No more than two graduate students shall be from the same division.
