

Major in Art History and Studio Art

Admission Requirements:

Completion of first-year requirements, including Studio Art 1601 or Studio Art 1605 or the former VAS 1025 or the former VAS 1020, and 1.0 course either from Art History 1640 or the former VAH 1040 or two of AH 1641A/B, AH 1642A/B, AH 1644A/B, AH 1646A/B or AH 1648A/B or the former VAH 1041A/B, the former VAH 1042A/B, the former VAH 1043A/B, the former VAH 1044A/B, and the former VAH 1045A/B, with a minimum grade of 60% in each course.
