PhD Candidacy Exam Topics Approval Form Department of Gender, Sexuality, and Women's Studies

The candidacy examination in GSWS is designed to provide students with the opportunity to map, and demonstrate mastery of, the fields of expertise that will inform their independent doctoral research. There are two options for the candidacy examination: (i) the student develops two course outlines, one aimed at the second-year level in an area that broadly informs their research, and one at the fourth-year level in an area that more specifically addresses their research topic; (ii) the student develops one course outline and one research paper (typically the course outline will be at the second-year level in an area that broadly informs the student's research topic and the research paper will focus more specifically on the student's research topic – although the course outline may be at the fourth-year level with approval from the supervisor and committee).
